In 1778 English historian Edward Gibbon, completed his classic five reasons for the fall of one of the greatest societies in human history. Do they sound familiar?

1. rapid increase in divorce
2. increasing higher taxes
3. mad craze for pleasure and brutal sports
4. building gigantic armaments
5. decay of religion

As I outlined in a previous newsletter, there is a direct correlation between crime and our very high divorce rate. ## Looking for Answers!

Two Nova Scotia murders that left communities shocked, numb and devastated.



*“Mommy Don't,” were the last words 12 year old Karissa cried out as her mother choked her to death, and tossed her semi-nude body into a snow bank!*

There are some crimes that just leave a community paralyzed with grief, but a mother killing her own child betrays our human senses. It disgusts our core being and values as it reveals the very worst of human behavior.

There are no explanations that would satisfy our internal abhorrence and repulsion. Bridgewater Deputy Police Chief John Collyer called Karissa's case, “one of the most horrendous” he's ever seen in two decades of policing.

The other revolting case occurred sixty miles away in Truro, where a grandson beat his grandmother beyond recognition, nearly decapitating her. She was a well known and respected native rights crusader, who earlier that evening of her brutal murder had given the grandson twenty dollars. The crown prosecutor described the accused as, “defiant, dangerous and deadly.” The sentencing judge heard the killer was drug crazed on crack cocaine, and “his years of poor choices led him down the path that could only end in tragedy.”

I don't mean to be so morbid, but another alarming crime that occurred in Medicine Hat, Alberta involved 12 year old girl and her 23 year old boyfriend. Her parents naturally objected to the relationship, and they were brutally killed. Even more disturbing, was the slashing of the throat of her eight year old brother by his sister. The adult offender had watched the movie, Natural Born Killer, and believed they had started their own “love legacy.” Police and jurors wiped away tears at the sight of the young child on his bed of toys with his neck slashed.

We all know that these types of horrific crimes occur in many communities, and it leaves everyone frozen in pain and anguish. A person's conscience has to be devoid of the God like nature that encompasses our being. The Bible teaches that evil is a present reality, and there is a power of darkness in life that can take hold of people. *“Believe it or not!”*

*HN (human nature) minus HN (holy nature) = Deviance & Crime*
